VOC's – Volatile Organic Compounds - Organic compounds are chemicals that contain carbon and are found in all living things. Volatile organic compounds, sometimes referred to as **VOCs**, are organic compounds that easily become vapors or gases. (Vented air from Stress Relieving Ovens)

Oil Deposits in Vent Stacks – (Fire Hazard)

Disposal of spent Paint and solvent – Hazardous Waste Stream
